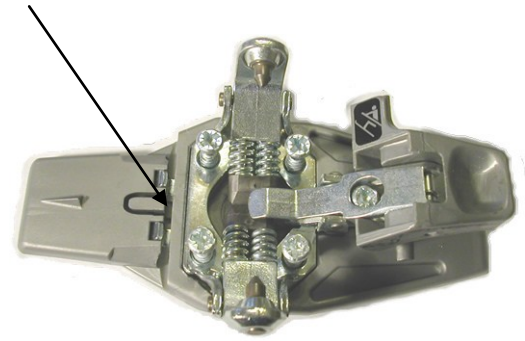

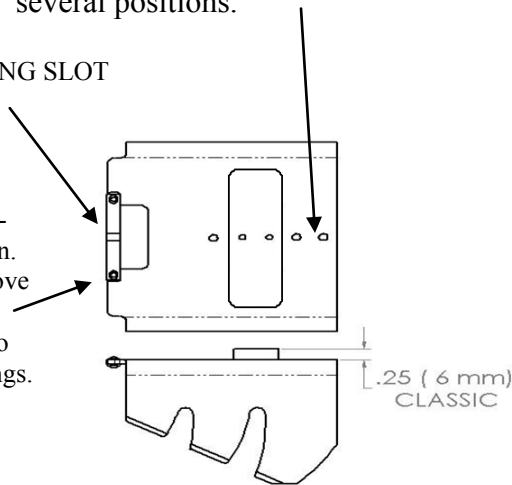
Crampon Mount



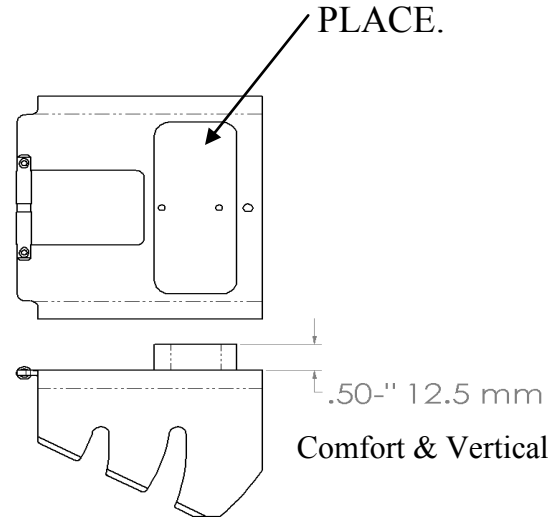
Holes for 6-32 flat head screws allow for mounting of the pressure assembly in any one of several positions.

CENTERING SLOT

Make sure stop nib has been removed (filed off) from crampon. Occasionally we forget to remove this nib for Dynafit users. Nib will interfere with insertion into crampon slot on Dynafit bindings.

### Installing crampon

Holding crampon to the side of crampon mount (located on the back end of toe piece), center pivot pin on crampon mount slot (keyhole shape). With top of crampon in a position 90 degrees from horizontal, slide crampon into crampon slot until centering finger in the crampon mount drops into slot on the center of pivot pin. Allow top of crampon to rotate down to a horizontal position which locks it in its lateral position.

**Make sure top of crampon is allowed to drop down parallel to ski prior to applying pressure with boot. This will avoid damage to base and crampon.**
